World Wide Web Day

World Wide Web Day is observed internationally on 1st August each year, highlighting the crucial role of telecommunication in today's modern world. This day emphasizes how the internet has brought the world closer together, allowing people to connect despite being miles apart. It has not only stabilised global connectivity but has also revolutionized trade and commerce worldwide. The theme for 2024 reflects these ongoing advancements.

The origins of this day trace back to late 1989, when British computer scientist Tim Berners-Lee proposed the concept of a global information space. His vision was to integrate computers and data networks into a unified, user-friendly global system. Berners-Lee initially presented his idea in March 1989, outlining a "universal linked information system." A year later, he refined this concept in collaboration with Belgian systems engineer Robert Cailliau, finalising the proposal in November 1990. By the end of that year, Berners-Lee had developed the first web server and web browser at CERN, where he worked. The inaugural website, info.cern.ch, was launched on 6th August, 1991. This simple page explained the World Wide Web project and provided users with instructions on how to navigate and use the system.

Berners-Lee's vision continues to hold significance today. In 2024, we still rely on the World Wide Web for advancements in healthcare, media, education, travel, and scientific research, fundamentally transforming lives.

INDIA'S OLYMPIC TURNOUT

India's campaign at the Paris 2024 Olympics was a resounding success, with the country securing six medals, including one silver and five bronze. The contingent, comprising IIO athletes competing across 16 sports, showcased exceptional talent and determination, cementing India's growing presence on the global sporting stage.

Shooter Many Bhaker etched her name in history by becoming the first Indian woman to win an Olympic medal in shooting, clinching bronze in the women's 10m air pistol event. Bhaker's achievement was further amplified when she and Sarabjot Singh won another bronze in the 10m air pistol mixed team event, making them the first Indian shooting pair to win an Olympic medal.

Javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra, the reigning Olympic and World champion, narrowly missed out on gold but secured a silver medal with a season–best throw of 89.45m.

The Indian men's hockey team continued its rich Olympic legacy by winning the bronze medal, defeating Spain 2-1 in a thrilling match. This was India's 13th Olympic medal in hockey and the first time since 1972 that the team had secured back-to-back medals.

Vinesh Phogat's experience at the Paris 2024 Olympics was marked by both promise and heartbreak. After a stellar performance that included victories over top competitors, she secured a place in the gold medal match. However, her hopes were dashed when she was disqualified for being 100 grams over the weight limit, despite having confirmed at least a silver medal. This disqualification followed her previous Olympic disappointments in Rio and Tokyo, leading Vinesh to announce her retirement.

India's overall performance, ranking 71st on the medals tally, was the country's joint second-highest total medal haul after the previous Games. The six medals won in Paris were a testament to the hard work, dedication, and talent of the Indian athletes, who continue to inspire a nation and raise the bar for future generations.

SHOPKEEPER AND CUSTOMER ROLE-PLAY ACTIVITY



अंतर सदन प्रतियोगिता



A Puzzle-Solving Prodigy:


Rohan Rao
